

**NOTICE ON THE PROTECTION OF NATURAL PERSONS
WITH REGARD TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**
Regulation (EU) 2016/679, Art. 13

The processing of personal data is based on the principles of lawfulness, fairness and transparency, in order to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons. To this end, the following information is provided:

1. The data controller is the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI) of the Italian Republic, which, in this specific case, acts through the Embassy of Italy in Washington, located at 3000 Whitehaven Street NW, 20008, Washington D.C., tel.: +1 (202) 612-4400 (switchboard), e-mail: econ.washington@esteri.it; certified e-mail (PEC): amb.washington@cert.esteri.it.
2. MAECI has a Data Protection Officer who, in the event of questions or complaints, may be contacted at the following contact details (Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, Piazzale della Farnesina 1, 00135 ROME, tel. +39 06 36911 (switchboard), e-mail: rpd@esteri.it; certified e-mail (PEC): rpd@cert.esteri.it.
3. The personal data requested are necessary for the selection of the Sponsor to whom the sponsorship will be awarded.
4. The provision of such data is mandatory under Italian law, and any refusal to provide the requested data will result in exclusion from the selection procedure or from the sponsorship.
5. The processing will be carried out manually or electronically by specifically authorized personnel.
6. The data will be communicated to MAECI's internal and external supervisory bodies. By signing this notice, the data subject consents to the communication of the aforementioned data also to the competent local authorities for verification purposes, and to the publication of the essential elements of the contract entered into on the contracting authority's website, in accordance with Italian legislation on the transparency of public contracts.
7. The data are retained for a maximum period of 5 years from the moment the contractual relationship ends, whether due to completion of performance or for any other reason, including termination for breach. This period is suspended in the event of the commencement of judicial proceedings.
8. The data subject may request access to and rectification of their personal data. In such cases, the data subject must submit a specific request to the contact details indicated in point 1, while also notifying the MAECI Data Protection Officer at the contact details indicated in point 2.
9. If the data subject believes their rights have been violated, they may lodge a complaint with the MAECI Data Protection Officer. Alternatively, they may contact the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la protezione dei dati personali) (Piazza Venezia 11, 00187 Rome, tel. +39 06 696771 (switchboard), e-mail: protocollo@gpdp.it, certified e-mail (PEC): protocollo@pec.gpdp.it) or to the competent judicial authority.
